Student Cellular Telephone Policy

Students may bring cellular telephones to school, and retain the telephones in their possession only under the following conditions:

1. The telephone must be powered **OFF** before entering the building. The telephone must remain **OFF** while in school.
2. The telephone must remain inside the book bag or purse, or be clipped "out of view" to the students' clothing.
3. No calls or text messages may be made or received within the building during school hours, including lunch periods.
4. **Parental permission to bring the phone is indicated by the signature below:**

This form is to be completed by the student and signed by a parent or guardian. Permission to carry a cell phone will be granted once forms are properly completed and submitted. Forms should be submitted during registration. Forms submitted after registration should be forwarded to the school clerk, Mrs. D. Wills-Grier. Students, who carry cell phones without parental consent, may be referred for Saturday School or suspension.

CELLULAR PHONE POLICY

Students, whose parents/guardians sign cellular phone contracts (see reverse side of this notice) authorizing that they be permitted to carry a cellular telephone are allowed to carry cell phones. The telephones must be powered off at all times in the building between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Students wishing to make cellular calls before or after the instructional day may do so by stepping outside the building to do so. No outgoing or incoming calls are allowed while the student is in the building.

Cellular phones should neither be seen, nor heard. Students must wear them discreetly under their clothing, or conceal them in their book bags/purses while in the building.
